

WHEN DO WE NEED REVIVAL?

- 1) When Altars are barren and lives are not being changed.
- 2) When Christians are lukewarm and Church services are dull and boring.
- 3) When God becomes a “spare tire” who is only called on in emergencies.
- 4) When families are in trouble and children are being captured by sin.

WHAT SHOULD REVIVAL ACCOMPLISH?

- 1) Make people search their hearts, acknowledge their sins, and turn from those sins.
- 2) Make people keenly aware of God’s presence in Church, in their home, in their life.
- 3) Bring people together in Love. Feuds ought to stop. Friends ought to fellowship
- 4) Turn Christians into Prayers Warriors instead of Pew Warmers
- 5) Increase Church attendance as people seek to be with God and His people.
- 6) Bring the Church back to its original purpose- Soul Winning.

THE MAIN THING BECOMES THE MAIN THING

WHAT ARE THE ADVANTAGES OF REVIVAL MEETINGS?

- 1) Repeated and consecutive preaching of the word of God [One man described Revival as "ReBIBLE". That's one thing it ought to do; get us back into the WORD consistently].
- 2) Serious and Continued Prayer for Self and Sinners.
- 3) The minds of the Lukewarm and the Lost are pointed toward their relationship with God.
- 4) An Excellent opportunity is available to invite the community, the family, co-workers, etc to come to Special Church Services.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IN A REVIVED CHURCH?

1. A Different Atmosphere- God’s Spirit will be at work
2. A Different Attitude- Joy instead of boring duty
3. Applied Preaching- Sermons will produce changed people.
4. Affection for each other- Hugs and help will be common
5. Appeal for Sinners- they respect the church and desire to have what it's got
6. Approval by God.- Blessings and Bounty

HOW CAN YOU GET INVOLVED IN REVIVAL?

- 1) **ATTEND**- Determine to make it a priority this week
- 2) **ADVERTISE**- Phone people, Personally Invite people
- 3) **AGONIZE**- Pray for the 5 people you want to see saved this week EVERY Day and then invite them to services.

4) **ANTICIPATE**- Sit beside those you invited. Share your Bible with them. Pray for them during service. Expect God to touch them. Come with a mint in your pocket and the plan of salvation ready to present when they come to the altar.



Remember- ONE PERSON IS OFTEN THE KEY TO REVIVAL.
